



# DEUTERONOMY

Read: Deuteronomy 1v19-40.



● **v20, 21:**

The land of the promises of God which He sets before you and before His church is vast and encompasses every field, both spiritual and material. As He sets it before you, He does not prescribe what you will get or possess - He simply makes it available. Individuals, churches - even whole nationalities - are distinguished by how much of what God makes available to all, they actually enter into and possess. This is not up to God, it is up to you. This revelation is also important for us in order to lift up the people of Africa from our mediocrity among nations. Think again on Ecclesiastes 9v11.

● **v22-25:**

A major key to whether you will enter in and possess the Promised Land is INFORMATION. You cannot enter into or possess what you know nothing about. For this reason, CURIOSITY, in particular concerning what God has promised and set before us, is a major key to your possessing or achieving for yourself and for the Kingdom of God. This is why Moses and the children of Israel needed to send twelve spies to search out the Promised Land. From now on, determine to be a curious person who researches and finds out about all that God has promised and about the land which is before and around you. Think on Hosea 4v6.

● **v22, 25, 28-31:**

These verses show us the objectives God wants you to pursue as you research, i.e. search out the land. Research the Scriptures as well as the real world around you.

- a. v22: Research helps you find out and determine what things or places you must enter in and possess, and what are the best ways or strategies to do so.
- b. v25: Assess or identify the actual fruits, benefits or achievements which are feasible in the territory you want to enter.
- c. v25: ' a good land' - assess the nature of fruit or accomplishments likely to be yielded by your efforts in that land.
- d. v 28: Assess the challenges you will need to face, surmount and overcome as you enter and possess the land.
- e. v 29-31 : As you gain knowledge about the land you must possess, take care that you do not get intimidated , nor open yourself to fear, unbelief and hesitation- even unwillingness to go forward. Keep yourself focused on the promise, power and ability of your Father God to be with you and to give you victory over every challenge and obstacle.
